

Lesson 4: Create your own Graphic Score

Introduction

- What is a graphic score?
 - A special way of representing music through the use of symbols that are different from "traditional notation".
- Why do we use this type of notation?
 - Anyone can participate! You don't need formal training in traditional music notation
 - Allows for lots of interesting music to be written
- Today you will create your own graphic score and perform your own!



Materials

- For this lesson, you will need
 - Hard Surface
 - Blank Paper
 - Pencil
 - Coloring supplies
 - o 3 household items as instruments:
 - Paper
 - Dried beans or rice
 - Pots or pans
- Optional:
 - Ruler or some sort of straight edge
 - Timer

- During this lesson, there will be no judgement and this is a safe place to explore and be creative! There are no wrong answers.




Creating your score!

- In each box, you will draw something:
 - It can be just a color
 - Shape or many shapes!
 - A picture
 - Lines
- Be creative! You can draw anything you would like.




Let's play your score!

- First, let's gather some instruments
 - You should have paper and silverware. Choose your own third "found instrument!"
- Let each box you draw inspire how you will improvise.
- To the right is a chart are some examples of how you can be inspired by what you drew.



Let's play your score!

- First, let's gather some instruments
 - You should have paper, pots/pans, and dried beans & rice.
- Start from the top left box and move one box at a time to the right.
 - You can perform each box for however long you would like.
 - Set a timer for 5 minute timer and perform the piece within 5 minutes
