

GALLERIES & STUDIOS

3 Art with Alejandro (5th Street Public Market, 246 E 5th Ave #224)

Witness the unveiling of Alejandro Sarmiento's latest creations! From completed pieces to works in progress, you'll have the opportunity to see the artist's process as he expands on previous works and delves deeper into new subjects.

4 ArtCity Studios on Broadway (160 E Broadway, basement)

Floral prints for sale and new floral watercolor and acrylic paintings on view by Sabrena Annelle. WheelHaus Arts, a teaching studio working with K-12th grade youth led by David 'CP' Placencia, shows a large collection of student prestige artworks ranging in sizes and mediums, as well as a last chance to buy artworks from the

previous year. Eugene Printmakers will be printing various Valentine's cards for sale from 6:30-8pm for \$3 each. Pick a favorite for your special someone.

5 Framin' ArtWorks (505 High St)

Steve Evans uses soft graphite pencils to create his work, which is inspired by nature, literature, and culture. Steve graduated from the Academy of Art in San Francisco, and later studied at UO and LCC.

6 Karin Clarke at the Gordon (590 Pearl St, Suite 105)

Work by gallery artists including Robert Schlegel, Heather Jacks, Mark Clarke, Margaret Coe, Adam Grosowsky, and others.

7 The New Zone Gallery (110 E 11th Ave)

An eclectic mix of art created by New Zone members; "Mystical Realms," paintings by Cheryl Owen-Wilson, taking us from what we can see with our own eyes to the fantasies of other worlds; "Exploring Mt Pisgah in Infrared," photography by Don Myer that expands our view of the world in colors and textures impossible to get with regular light; PhotoZone Gallery Members Exhibition, showing diverse subjects and photographic technique; "Art in Birds," birdhouses creatively painted by Dennis Arendt, part of a project of the McKenzie River Trust on Green Island.

8 OSLP Arts & Culture Center (110 E 11th Ave, Suite C)

Check out "SHOWCASE!" at the new gallery space, featuring fresh amazing artwork created by Arts & Culture Center participants.

9 Windowfront Exhibitions


Empty storefronts become galleries! A 224 W Broadway - "Vexing me!" a multi-medium installation by Zoë Gamell Brown welcomes visitors to a Guyanese American meal.

B 120 W Broadway - "Celestial Migration," a mural by Valentina Gonzalez (VRGNZ) of the creation story of the Coyote and the Jaguar.

C 833 Willamette St - "Altered Cumulus," an installation by Justin Kittell and James Sartor, consisting of 10 glowing clouds strung from an octahedral frame. The clouds are synced together and rotate through an assortment of light modes, sometimes evoking lightning and other times calm skies.

D 873 Willamette St - The art of Leo White Horse, a Sicangu Lakota artist with ancestors from the Rosebud Sioux Reservation in South Dakota, is influenced by the sketches of cowboys, rodeos, and natives from the past that were drawn by his father (Myers White Horse). Sue Gallego's identity as an Indigenous woman has shaped her development as an artist, as she feels a responsibility for depicting the emotional values and stories of indigenous people and cultures.

E 1059 Willamette St - "A Sunset Together," a mural by Patrick Price using traditional formline designs and ancient petroglyph styles.

SHOP & EXPLORE

10 Allies LLC (131 E 11th Ave) With the mission of supporting adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, Allies hosts the theme "Stay Gorgeous" with new artworks by their customers. See works by featured artist Mario celebrating his love for his girlfriend and Valentine's Day or speak with artist Cromika about her crochet artwork. Offer up snacks of gratitude to their group sculpture "Eco" or create your own valentine!

11 Books with Pictures Eugene (99 W Broadway C) The fantastical work of "illumimancer" Travis Pendlebury.

12 Broadway Commerce Center (44 W Broadway) "{Khaostasis 11.0- Amalgam}," an exhibit by David "CP" Placencia featuring original paintings that culminate his 10 years of showing on ArtWalks since his first show in January 2012. These include large austere landscapes, fun 3D Bubble artworks, mural studies, and owls.

13 Epic Seconds (30 E 11th Ave) The One Wall Gallery shows paintings by Montclair, NJ artist Scott Beck. Beck paints images that feel reminiscent of old television stills, like little reminders of the ways we once told and inhabited our stories. In a contemporary context, Beck seems to suggest that the ways we connect, like social media, have the capability of making us antiques of our own expression.

14 Eugene Public Library (100 W 10th Ave) Open until 6pm. * Children's Center, 1st floor - Meet Little BIG Bear & Friends via the "Giant Cover Art Display" of platinum award winning books by father and son author and illustrator team "Chef Andre" Royal & Andre Royal Jr. * Magazines and Newspapers Room, 2nd floor - "Our Conversations Begin Around the Table," a collection by Out of Our Minds, a guild of professional women artists in Eugene.

15 Oregon Art Supply (1020 Pearl St) Check out art made by the staff of Oregon Art Supply, including original works by Clayton Sukau, Emily (Looman) Hildebrand, Angel Peihuan Chen, Kianah Clark, and Cassie Taylor. Open until 7pm.

16 Pause Installations F Community Cup Coffee, 901 Pearl St G Broadway Metro, 888 Willamette St (on West Broadway windows) H Oregon Contemporary Theatre offices, 174 W Broadway

If we could press pause on Eugene for a moment, what would it look like? Pause is a series that explores how small moments, over time, have built our community. For these exterior installations, community members were interviewed, and then artist Kelsey Leib created pieces in ink and thread to share these reflections and experiences.
