# Lesson 3: Printing with Alternative Materials

# Printing with Alternative Materials

- Using your dried prints from last week, try printing with alternative materials and methods
- If possible, use objects with holes in the middle, like vegetable net bags or lace, if you don't have access to those, use a leaf, a lid or other flat shape, or a stencil



# Adding a 2nd Layer with stencil or new material

I will model how to start a 2nd layer & show you how to print with some alternative materials

Now let's do it together, keeping in mind:

Some "Stencils" need to sit for a few hours to dry in order to make a good print

Place a piece of lace, net, or other material with holes in it and try spraying paint on top of it to make a print
